### BORROWED CLOTHING

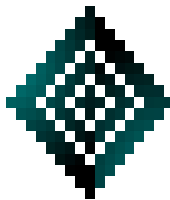
If your child borrowed any clothing from the preschool, please return it before the end of the preschool year. Thank You!
